Teaching Pedagogy

Our curriculum is based on *Outcome-Based Education (OBE)*, with clear goals that match the needs of the profession. Reflection and feedback are important parts of our system, helping students track their progress and grow.

Teaching–Learning Methods

We use a variety of teaching methods to make learning interesting and effective. These include *interactive presentations*, expert *lectures*, and *practical training* in our in-house clinics and labs. Students also take part in case discussions based on real clinical examples to build *problem-solving* and *decision-making skills*.
