Detailed Program Schedule:

Kadam Association, Department of Environmental Science, Faculty of Science, SGT University, Gurugram organized a Quiz competition and an Oral Presentation competition on the occasion of World Ozone Day-2023. The theme of Oral Presentations was "Montreal Protocol: fixing the ozone layer and reducing climate change". Dr. Rachna Bhateria, Associate Professor, Department of Environmental Science, Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak has been invited as chief guest. Mr. Niladri Sekhar Roy, Co-advisor, Kadam Association hosted the entire program. The participants were enrolled through google form shared earlier. Prof (Dr.) Lakhwinder Singh, Dean, faculty of Science addressed the participants and felicitated the expert and chief guest Dr. Rachna Bhateria. Screening of the quiz completion was taken care of by Dr. Simranjeet Singh, advisor, Kadam Association, Miss. Ritu Bhatt, Assistant Professor, and Mr. Wazir Singh, Research scholar, Department of Environmental Science. Five amongst six teams were screened for competition. The entire quiz competition was of five rounds followed by an oral presentation competition. There were seven competitors for the presentation. After both the competitions, Dr. Bhateria delivered an expert talk on the theme and also gave her judgment to the oral presentation competition along with Dr. Nutan Sharma, Associate Professor, Department of Chemistry. After the talk session, prizes were distributed to the winners. First prize in the Quiz competition went to Team D- Sudesh, Sophia and Meghana of M.Sc, Environmental Science, IIIrd Semester. Second Prize Quiz went to Team B- Jaspriya, Sneha and Yukti, BOTT, IIIrd Semester. Not only the winners but fifteen participants from the audience received gifts for right answers. Approximately hundred participants from different faculties attended the event. The event was concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Simranjeet Singh. It was a very successful and joyful event for students as well as for the faculty members.
